CHICAGO FIRE ACTOR, TENOR CURTIS BANNISTER VISITS BALTIMORE SCHOOL FOR THE ARTS



October 3, 2018, Baltimore: Curtis Bannister – a Peabody Conservatory alumnus, acclaimed tenor, and actor on NBC's *Chicago Fire* – will visit the Baltimore School for the Arts for a master class with voice students there on Friday, October 12. Bannister is in Baltimore preparing for his October 26 performance as The Celebrant in the Peabody Institute's performance of Leonard Bernstein's *MASS*, during which the Baltimore School for the Arts Chamber Choir will also perform. At the master class, he is expected to deliver a short performance, answer students' questions about his career and singing,

and offer feedback and coaching to student performers.
